PS Glass Etch Vinyl



FEED MATERIAL into cutter so that the paper carrier is on the bottom.



REMOVE PAPER CARRIER by gently "rolling" the carrier off the back of the vinyl. carrier until ready to apply to substrate.

Recommended Substrates

Window Store Fronts Glass Doors Glassware Glass-like Substrates

CUT image in positive form.



PREP SURFACE-Be certain the surface of the substrate is smooth, clean and lint-free before positioning the vinyl graphic.



WEED away excess material leaving only the desired graphic on the carrier.



POSITION GRAPHIC— Use squeegee to remove any air bubbles.





REMOVE PRE-MASK AND FINISH APPLICATION. Once graphic is positioned as desired, remove the Pre-Mask Tape and repeat center of design out, with fingers. Do not use squeegee directly on vinyl.

If air bubbles remain, simply puncture with small straight pin and press out with fingers.
